

Dress Down Day Guidelines/Rules
2008-2009

Please make sure you familiarize yourself with these rules/guidelines BEFORE you dress for "Dress Down Day" so you will know what is expected and be able to be successful:

1. **PANTS:** may be any color and material EXCEPT FLANNEL; **NO PAJAMA OR FLANNEL PANTS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME;** pants may not be torn or ripped; anything written/designed on pants must be school appropriate (cargo pants are OK on Dress Down Days)
2. **SHIRTS/TOPS:** must cover the body with no midriff and/or back showing; no "spaghetti strap" tops (straps must be at least 2 inches wide), **no plunging necklines**, no "muscle" shirts, no "see through" tops/shirts. Anything written on tops/shirts must be school appropriate; not to be ripped or torn
3. **When we have "crazy hair" day:** you may wear your hair any style you wish and you may have any color you wish in it, HOWEVER...please remember that it must be "back to regular Code" the next school day.
4. ***THE REMAINDER OF THE NORMAL WayPoint DRESS CODE IS TO BE FOLLOWED AS IT IS WRITTEN IN THE STUDENT HANDBOOK.***
