Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2010-2011 educational progress for WayPoint Academy. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Mr. Reedell Holmes, Superintendent, for assistance.

For 2010-2011, WayPoint Academy did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) because 95% of all students were not tested. Because our school has not made AYP for 2 years, we are identified for School Improvement. In order for WayPoint to make Adequate Yearly Progress, we will have extended instructional time for students in a structured school program for a 6 week period in the fall, winter, and spring, 2 days a week, for 1 hour a day. Saturday school will also be provided for a 6 week period in the fall for 3 hours a day. Curriculum Crafter has been implemented to help align curriculum with the State standards. Data from State and local assessments will be reviewed and analyzed to help drive differentiated instruction.

Parental involvement will be of utmost importance to ensure the attendance of their child regularly to school during school and extended instructional time and during testing. WayPoint will host monthly PTO/PTA meetings and family literacy, math, science, reading, and writing nights throughout the year to encourage parental involvement.

State law requires that we also report this additional information to our parents.

1. WayPoint's process for assigning pupils to the school is: All of the following items must be turned in with your completed application to be eligible for acceptance during open enrollment: Affirmation of Prior Discipline, Home Language Questionnaire, Original Birth Certificate, Copy of Immunization Report, copy of most recent grade report for 6-9th grade/or copy of full transcript for 10th-12th grade, copy of MEAP test results, and a copy of the IEP and MET for Special Education students. Open Enrollment ends April 22, 2011 at 3:00 PM. When Open Enrollment ends, applications will be counted, and if there are fewer applications than openings, all complete applications will be accepted. If there are more applications than openings, a lottery will be held.
2. WayPoint Academy's School Improvement Plan has been approved for the 2010-2011 school year and the 2011-2012 school year is transmitted and waiting approval from the State.
3. WayPoint Academy is a 6th – 12th grade school that specializes in preparing their students for success after graduation.

Core Curriculum will be implemented this year using the Curriculum Crafter Tool. Curriculum Crafter is currently aligned to Michigan's content expectations and will help aide teachers in curriculum development.
5. Students take the NWEA – MAP Assessments three times a year: Fall, Winter, and Spring. These assessments are analyzed and the results drive instruction.
6. 50% of our Parents participated at our Parent/Teacher Conferences throughout the 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 school years.
7. High School students had:
 - a. 3 students, 10% of the 11th and 12th grades that were dual enrolled in postsecondary education.
 - b. There were no college equivalent courses offered here at WayPoint Academy.
 - c. There were no students enrolled in college equivalent courses here at WayPoint.
